Free Shuttle Service Available to Aggie Stadium and Vendors Pavilion

As a convenience to all Aggie alumni, family and friends attending the 2005 A&T Homecoming festivities on Saturday, Oct. 15, the City of Greensboro (Greensboro Transit Authority) and the Greensboro Convention and Visitors Bureau, in conjunction with North Carolina A&T State University, will offer shuttle bus service to and from Aggie Stadium and the vendors pavilion located at the corner of Dudley and Lindsay streets — free of charge!

Patrons may board the shuttle at the Sheraton Four Seasons, Park Lane, Drury Inn and Comfort Inn hotels. Patrons also may board the shuttle at the park-and-ride lot located at the J. Douglas Galyon Depot on Washington St., or at the public parking decks on Church St. and Davie St. Accessible transportation will be provided for individuals with special needs.

The shuttle will run continuously every 20 minutes beginning at 7 a.m. until approximately 6:30 p.m., depending on the completion of the game. By riding the shuttle, patrons will have quick access to Aggie Stadium without the hassle of finding a parking space and walking to the stadium.
